IF ANY Party does not think the time estimate given is enough they should give notice to the authority at the address below at once.

ANY PARTY who wishes to withdraw any representations they have made may do so by giving notice at the address below.

The Applicant shall also find accompanying this notice, the objection which has been made on behalf of the Chief Officer of Humberside Police.

Where all parties agree that a hearing is no longer necessary the authority may dispense with the hearing. UNLESS notified otherwise, by Law and Democratic Services, the hearing of this application SHALL take place as specified in this notice.

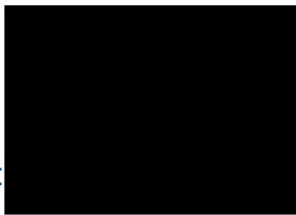
Notice of Hearing/AM
