**LO STATEMENT OF
 GARTON 3071**

Introduction

1. My name is 3071 Garton and I am a Licensing Officer in the Licensing Department of Humberside Police based at Grimsby Police Station, Victoria Street, Grimsby. I cover the county of North east Lincolnshire. I am under the direction and control of the Chief Constable of Humberside Police ('the Chief Constable'). My duties include consideration of the impact of crime and disorder and the Chief Constable's response to licensing matters.
2. I have been Police Staff since 2008. Prior to taking up my current role in the Licensing Team in March 2026, I worked as Front Counter Officer at Victoria Street Police Station. I am therefore familiar with problems of alcohol related crime and disorder and the protection of children from harm in both my current and previous roles.
3. On the 4th August 2026 Humberside Police received a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) from the Respondent to take place at West Marsh Community Centre, Beeston Street Grimsby, DN31 2QH: to take Place on the 5th November 2026.
4. I make this statement in support of upholding The Licensing Objectives. I believe the Grant of this TEN would undermine all 4 of the below objectives.
 - The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - Public Safety
 - The Prevention of Public Nuisance

- The Protection of Children from Harm

Background

5. Under the Licensing Act 2003 anybody can apply for a TEN under section 8 of the Licensing Act. Police and Environmental health can object to a Ten application under extreme circumstances.

Below extraction of the 182 Guidance:

6. 7.35 Such cases might arise because of concerns about the scale, location, timing of the event or concerns about public nuisance – even where the statutory limits on numbers are being observed. The premises user who signs the form is legally responsible for ensuring that the numbers present do not exceed the permitted limit at any one time. In cases where there is reason to doubt that the numbers will remain within the permitted limit the premises user should make clear what the nature of the event(s) is and how they will ensure that the permitted persons limit will not be exceeded. For example, where notices are being given for TENs simultaneously on adjacent plots of land it may be appropriate for door staff to be employed with counters. In each case it is important that licensing authorities and relevant persons can consider whether they believe that the premises user intends to exceed the 499 person limit or will be unable to control or know whether the limit will be exceeded. Where the planned activities are likely to breach the statutory limits or undermine the licensing objectives, it is likely to be appropriate for the police or EHA to raise objections.
7. The Respondent Kye Hill has submitted a temporary event notice for a firework event with attractions described a firework display, juvenile funfair rides, food and drink. The date of this event is to take place on Thursday 5th November 2026 between the hours of 17:30hrs and 20:30hrs. The notice states it is for the sale of alcohol and regulated entertainment.

History

8. On the 7th July 2026 Police received an email from North East Lincolnshire council stating that Kye HILL had applied for a TEN to sell alcohol at his upcoming event, the screening of the world cup match England v Norway to be held the 11th JULY 2026 at Morrisons car boot field Grimsby. HILL was advised by the council his application had been rejected as it was applied for too late and outside of the required time frame – The council advised HILL he could not sell alcohol but he could allow people to bring their own – HILL flagged some concerns about

glass being bought to the event – North East Lincolnshire Council advised HILL he could say “no glass allowed “due to health and safety purposes. North East Lincolnshire council had also requested that HILL provide them with an event management plan, medical plan and insurance documents for the upcoming event. HILL failed to provide this information. Please see exhibit LG01.

9. On the 10TH July 2026 Police shared social media photographs with Humberside Fire and Rescue and North East Lincolnshire Council, taken from Lincolnshire Competitions Facebook page. The advertisement showed live football on a big screen, family friendly, drink available, food and advertising a fireworks display. Within the comments of this advert persons comment on the Facebook pages asked, “can we bring smoke grenades” a response by Lincolnshire competitions ltd replied “red ones will be for sale inside”. Within the same email chain Iain PECK from Council Licensing advised he had contacted Kye HILL for expected numbers and HILL responded that he would send the council an event and medical plan along with a copy of insurance documents that afternoon. Please see exhibit LG02.
10. Police log number 329 11/07/2026 was created for the showing of England v Norway. Police attended the event being held at Morrisons field. Police spoke with Kye Hill at the event at 15:40hrs who confirmed to officers that he had; 4 x paramedics, 2 x first responders provided by Grimsby Emergency Medic Services, 10 x SIA badged security staff that would be working the event along with 20 x wardens that would be patrolling, litter picking and managing the crowd. Kye HILL had advised that all people attending would be searched and he would have a zero tolerance for glass and pyros and he plans to eject anyone causing any disorder. They advised police that they had sent copies of public liability insurance and medic plans over to the local authority via the ESAG but they could be made available to police if required. At 19:00hrs Police reattended at the event and spoke with gate staff to request names and details of security badges. All parties in high visibility at the gates stated they did not have SIA badges. Kye HILL has approached officers and refused to provide details for the security staff and stated that 8 of them did have SIA badges and provided a mobile number for officers to contact for him to provide this information however would not provide it at that time in person. Please see exhibit LG03.
11. On 13th July 2026 North East Lincolnshire council confirmed via email that Kye Hill had not provided any information regarding an event management plan or public liability insurance. Please see exhibit LG04.
12. On the 13th 2026 July Trading Standards sent an email to Iain PECK from council licensing advising of a further advertisement on Facebook from Lincolnshire Competitions. This event was for the semi final event on the 15th July 2026 with gates opening at 17:00, this also advertised a fireworks finale. Please see exhibit LG05.

13. Police log number 392 15/07/2026 was raised for the England v Argentina game and night time economy incidents. Police attended the event at Morrisons field and spoke with Kye HILL. HILL informed officers that he had six thousand people in attendance at the event held on the 11/07/2026 and is expecting more to attend at this evenings event. As the evening progressed Police received further information that approx. seven and a half thousand people were in attendance at this event, concerns were raised around members of the public bringing their own drinks and glass, the event was advertised as no glass and was clearly not being adhered to and enforced by the event organisers this was stamped on the Log at 20:32. Police report disruptive behaviour with people in the crowd throwing beer cans and lit flares which were being sold on site. Reports of injured people requiring hospital treatment with groups of angry family's leaving the site as early as 20:32. Please see exhibit LG06.
14. Police Inspector McGlynn was the operational commander for the World Cup Events over seeing staffing and events being held during the screening of the England games. Inspector McGlynn has provided a duty statement for both events held by Kye HILL at Morrison on the 11/07/2026 and the 15/07/2026. Please see exhibit LG07
15. On the 16/07/2026 at 11:01 an email was sent to North East Lincolnshire Council from Grimsby Medical Services LTD who had been contracted by Kye Hill to provide medical services and a risk Assessment for both events being held at Morrisons on the 11th and 15th July 2026. This email raised by John Huitson-Broom Chief executive of Grimsby Event Medical Services raised concerns that when he agreed to provide medical cover for both these events he was advised by Kye HILL that the numbers he was expecting was a maximum of 2000 attendees. Contained within the email John reports that on the 11th July they had dealt with a small number of casualties mainly due to alcohol intoxication and a female with a suspected broken ankle and a female presenting as unconscious and unresponsive. The main concerns raised by John for the event on the 11th July were; Marshalls/stewards staff had no form of communications. No SIA staff were present. More then 2000 people in attendance. Underage drinking. Two areas had been created, one for families and one described as the "lively area" however no control was being taken over both areas. John states that his major concerns were around the event that was held on the 15th July and namely the medical plan that had been submitted as the organiser had specifically requested 4 medics for 2000 attendees. John reports that as the night developed there were around 7000 attendees. It was also apparent that there were red flares for sale at this event. John then reports that he and his team witnessed smoke flares being thrown into the crowds and shortly after this they had their first casualties starting to appear to receive treatment. 15-20 casualties were treated by the medical team of which a majority were burns that were a result of being hit by flares. John states within his email that under normal circumstances he would have required the event organiser to stop the event however neither him or his team were

confident that this would happen, so he and his staff remained at the site and deal with the casualties . Attached is a copy of the email from John and also a copy of an email from Insp McGlynn to the licensing department also raising concerns around the event that had been held. Please see exhibit LG08.

16. Fireworks remain the Polices principal concern. Please see injuries documented in LG07. Under the Government guidance for Health and Safety with regards to Firework displays, there needs to be a fallout zone to protect the Public , this comes under section 131 of the Highways Act which also gives proximity to the highway. Please see exhibit LG09
17. Kye Hill is the sole applicant of the Temporary Event Notice dated 4th August in which Humberside Police are wishing to object. Please see exhibit LG10
18. Police have significant concerns around this TEN given the history and serious concerns of events run by the applicant previously around all four licensing objectives. There is a serious risk to the public evidenced by previous unsafe events which resulted in serious injuries, disorder and offences which occurred as a result of poor dispersal management.

We have received a TEN from Kye Hill this afternoon to sell alcohol and late night refreshment at Morrisons Car Boot Field for the England vs Norway game 11th July 26. I have spoken to him today and followed up in an email stating the TEN is too late and he won't be permitted to sell alcohol, but people can bring their own refreshments without the need for a TEN as they have done in previous years. He stated he was worried about glass so I have said if he wanted to state no glass could be brought in for safety purposes, that would be a decision he could make as the event organiser.

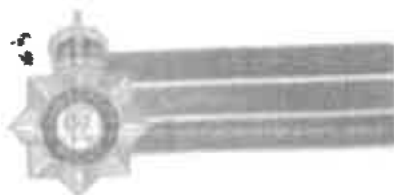

Further to our conversation earlier, please find a summary of what we know.

Kye Hill (Lincolnshire Competitions) is planning an event to show the England v Norway match on Saturday evening.

I have limited information, but I am aware that he cannot sell alcohol as he did not apply for a temporary event notice within the required timescale. As a result, he is encouraging people to bring their own alcohol.

It is believed he intends to sell food, which he can do up until 2300hrs without a licence.

There is information to suggest that he intends to distribute smoke grenades.

I am told there is a history of Kye running events such as bonfire/firework displays without Local Authority permission, which resulted in an injunction against him. On this occasion, he has made arrangements with local landowners.

One concern is the proximity of the dual carriageway and the use of smoke grenades. I understand given the timescales that there won't be a temporary event plan, however, if you could raise awareness with your colleagues and place a trigger as discussed.

WITNESS STATEMENT

(Criminal Procedure Rules, r 16. 2; Criminal Justice Act 1967, s. 9)

In JULY 2026, I took the role of a police Inspector for Op Advance which was Humberside Police's response to operational deployments over the World Cup 2026. As part of this role, I worked as an Operational Commander in the Force Control Room on the 5th JULY 2026, 11th JULY 2026 and 15th JULY 2026, which were the dates for the knockout England fixtures during this tournament. As part of my role on the 11th JULY 2026 I became aware of a large-scale viewing event being held at an area described as "Morrisons Car-boot Fields", LACEBY ROAD, GRIMSBY. The event which was hosted by Lincolnshire Competitions Ltd, was described as having two zones and two viewing screens, a funfair and a firework display. The information and intelligence surrounding this event suggested that spectators would be encouraged to bring their own alcohol, but that food would be sold. This was supported by the information that the event did not hold an alcohol licence. Further to this, there was an additional suggestion that smoke grenades would also be sold.

I am aware that officers made regular engagements with the event organisers, Lincolnshire Competitions, through Kye HILL and Holly GUEST, during the day of the event and asked questions surrounding event safety and management. I am able to produce an online advertisement for this event as ELM/01/07082026, this advertisement was provided as part of the intelligence picture for this event and was obtained from online social media.

The number of people estimated to be in attendance at the event was approximately 3000 people a large proportion of which were thought to be families. There were no reported incidents prior to the fixture kick off or during the fixture on this date. The team of officers patrolling the area around this event, reported concerns at half-time during which a large number of attendees went to McDonalds to use the toilet facilities believing there to be insufficient facilities inside the event.

Following the end of the fixture there was a 999 call to Humberside Police reporting that 5-6 individual, that had been in attendance at the event, where fighting on LACEBY ROAD, GRIMSBY. It was unclear what the trigger for this was or the details of those involved.

I continued with the role of Operational Commander into the England fixture on the 15th JULY 2026, during which the event at "Morrisons Car-boot Fields" was again hosted by Lincolnshire Competitions Ltd. On this occasion the event organisers reported that there were approximately 7500 in attendance. The officers patrolling this area consulted with staff to see how this attendance was being monitored and they were advised as it was an un-ticketed event it was being monitored by "clicker". I am able to produce an online advertisement for this event as ELM/02/07082026, this advertisement was provided as part of the intelligence picture for this event and was obtained from online social media

There were no reported incidents prior to the fixture kick off at this event, however following kick-off reports of pockets of disorder were made to officers by families who were actively seen to be leaving the event as they deemed it to be unsafe, and were also reported by first-aid staff allocated to the event. These pockets of disorder included incidents whereby smoke bombs and flares were being let off in the crowd, specifically following the England goal. These pyrotechnics were believed to have been sold by the event organisers. The first aiders on scene reported treating individual's for burn injuries believed to have been sustained through the reckless ignition of such items. As a precaution, I pre-emptively made

contact with Humberside Fire and Rescue Service, for shared situational awareness should they receive any calls for service and they generated their log reference 15939.

Colleagues at the event reported that they had spoken with the lead first aid provider, John HUITSON-BROOM of Grimsby Medical Services Ltd, who was extremely concerned with the safety of the event, and was frustrated that the event did not reflect what had been described to him when his team had agreed to provide provisions as a first aid team for it. HUITSON-BROOM described that as a result of the flare/ pyrotechnics being sold and used recklessly they were experiencing injuries that they had not anticipated. HUITSON-BROOM also disclosed to officers that their understanding of the event was that it would be family orientated and alcohol free but that there were a number of food stalls insider the event perimeter selling alcohol.

The medical team at the event described treating 9 people for burn injuries, the majority of which were children and a large proportion of which had facial injuries. Some of these injured children were sent to hospital for onward treatment and since the event I have been made aware that one of these children attended a specialist burns hospital for enhanced treatment.

The list of those treated by the medical team and their injury details are as follows, of note names are available but I have sanitised them due to age:

- 14 year old male- struck by a flare to the left side of his neck, treated at scene.
- 14 year old male- struck by a flare in the face, taken to hospital.
- 21 year old female- struck by a flare to the arm, treated at scene.
- 17 year old female- struck by a flare to the cheek, treated at scene.
- 14 year old male- struck by firework debris, treated at scene.
- 17 year old female- struck by flare to the arm, treated at scene.
- 15 year old male- struck by flare to side of neck, treated at scene.
- 12 year old male- struck by "smoke flare" to the face, taken to hospital.
- 15 year old female- struck by flare to the upper arm, treated at scene.

Following the end of the fixture and the closure of the event there were several reports of incidents of violence, which included small pockets of individuals fighting throughout the exits of the event. In addition to this there were reports from the nearby McDonald's of approximately 1000 people trying to enter the premise at the same time, which it simply does not have the capacity for. This caused staff to press their internal distress alarms, and following this a substantial amount of criminal damage was caused to the drive through area of the store, leading to its early closure for the evening. The damage caused was described as the screens used for ordering having been ripped off their stands.

It is my belief from the information I have been provided with around the event that these incidents, which led to significant injuries and substantial damage could have been avoided. I believe that effective planning and professional event management by the organisers would have eliminated this. It was clear from the exits surrounding the event that there had been no consideration for crowd dynamics, traffic management or emergency procedures. In addition to this there are evident deficiencies in the oversight of sales namely for alcohol and pyrotechnics (smoke grenades and flares) which have undoubtedly led to the significant injuries of children, which were clearly avoidable. This is supported by the statements of the event assigned first aid team, who were openly alarmed by the contrast and dynamics of the actual event in comparison to its description in their acceptance of employment at it.

This statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.

Subject: Safety issues relating to Lincolnshire Competitions Events in Grimsby 11th and 15th July

You don't often get email from john@gems.care. Learn why this is important

Good Morning

I'm writing to raise concerns in relation to the safety of two events that have been run by Lincolnshire Competitions on the Morrisons Car Boot Sale site off Hilmore Road in Grimsby on the 11th and 15th July this year.

My company Grimsby Event Medical Services Ltd (GEMS) was contracted to provide medical cover for these events and advised that a maximum of 2000 attendees were expected and no alcohol would be sold on the premises. With this in mind I created the medical plans which are attached.

These are plans based on templates that we have worked to over the past 12 months with no issue and that other customers have submitted to ESAG with no queries raised. GEMS are a limited company registered with Companies House (16488024) and insured by Hiscox Insurance with Public Liability to £10m.

On the 11th July we attended the event and dealt with a small number of casualties mainly alcohol intoxication but also a female with a suspected broken ankle and a female presenting as unconscious and unresponsive. The former was treated and sent to A&E, the latter required us to call in a front line EMAS ambulance which arrived in around 23 minutes - the casualty subsequently 'came round' and refused treatment.

Our concerns in relation to the event on the 11th are as follow:

- Marshalls / Stewarding staff had no communications
- No SIA security staff were present
- The attendance was in excess of the 2000 stipulated
- Under age drinking
- A family area and a 'lively' area had been separated off - however there was no control on children passing between the two.

In fairness - these are relatively minor with the exception of the excess crowd numbers. My team on the night consisted of an Emergency Care Assistant (FREC4), two First Responders (FREC3) and an Advanced First Aider. We coped but it wasn't comfortable.

The major concern is in relation to the event held last night (15th July). Bearing in mind the medical plan had again been submitted and the organiser specifically requested 4 medics for 2000 attendees, I actually deployed 5 medics this time comprising the following

1 x HCPC Registered Paramedic
1 x RGN Registered Nurse
1 x Emergency Care Assistant
2 x First Responders (FREC 3)

Again, as the night developed - the crowd far exceeded the 2000 and it is our belief reached around 7000 at one point this can be clearly made out in aerial photos on social media. It became apparent early on that a person or persons were selling red smoke flares within the event. The organiser denied knowledge of this and claimed that if flares were to be sold - he wanted to be the one doing it and making the money.

At this point we started to witness smoke flares being thrown within the crowd and our first casualties appearing. In all we treated 15 - 20 casualties the majority of which were burns from being hit by these flares. Some of these included superficial burns to faces, shoulders, chests and so on. On speaking to the Police who were present but holding outside, their response was that the flares were being sold at the event and there was 'nothing they could do about it' - this doesn't seem right to me.

As medical provider - I could at that point have withdrawn my team and left the event without cover which should under normal circumstances have required the organiser (hill investments) to stop the event. Neither I nor my team were confident that the organiser would have stopped the event and therefore we chose to remain and deal with the casualties as they presented.

We had been advised prior to this event again that no alcohol would be served on site - it was all 'bring your own' two of the stall holders (a noodle bar and a slushy stand) were both selling alcohol - the noodle bar selling 'buzz bombs' and cans of beer while the slushy stand was selling 'Vodka slushy's'

For an event that therefore was selling alcohol on the premises and had more than 2000 attendees, again there were no SIA security personnel present - purely Marshalls in a relatively small number. Once again, we witnessed significant underage drinking and on approaching the Police were advised that it was for the event security to police.

In hindsight I'm beginning to query whether this event went through the necessary 'licensing' and ESAG processes, they also had live music acts, fairground rides in addition to the big screen which essentially made these festivals.

I am happy to speak with anyone in relation to this and can provide copies of our records for inspection.

Good morning all,

Please make yourselves aware of the below information which is taken from the Op Advance report on 15/07/2026. I appreciate there hasn't been a lot we can do in relation to previous of events due to this event being privately organised on private land but I'm hopeful that this may change following some of the incidents and disclosures this evening.

Of note, there was an agreement that no alcohol would be sold at this event as it is not licenced, however, the medical lead has disclosed that alcohol was being sold by the food vendors at the event.

In addition to this, pyrotechnics including flares and smoke bombs were sold, leading to the injuries of at least 9 people whom needed medical treatment, some of which are believed to be juveniles.

CI Booth and I are hopeful that a joint approach can be taken alongside partner agencies to ensure that such incidents do not reoccur at any further event hosted by Lincolnshire Competitions.

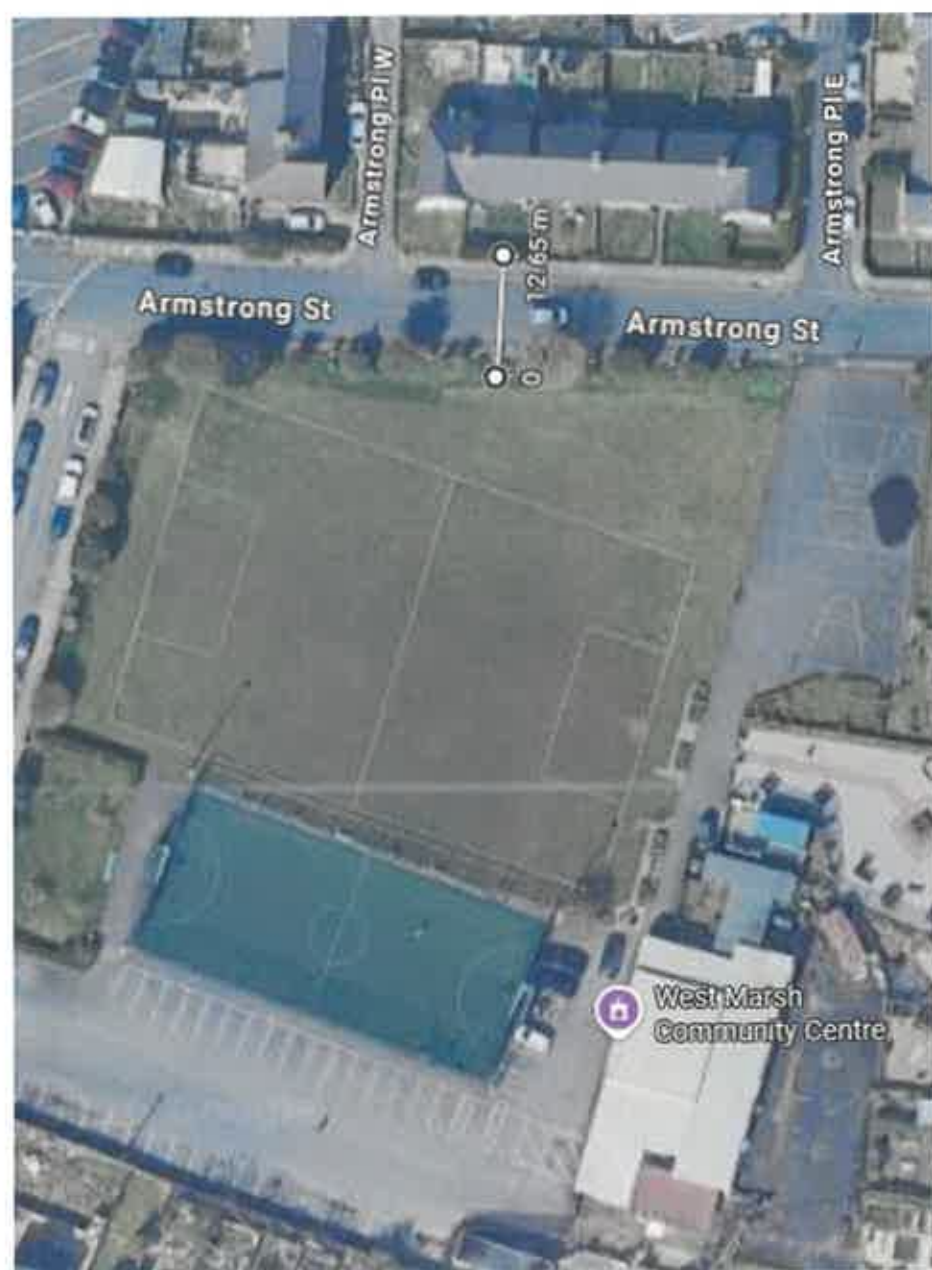
Morrisons Fields, LACEBY ROAD, GRIMSBY

Event organisers/staff reported that there were approximately 7500 people in attendance at the event. This is believed to have been monitored via a clicker used to count those entering. There were no incidents prior to KO, however following KO reports of pockets disorder were made to officers on scene on the perimeters of the event. These included incidents whereby smoke bombs and flares were being let off in the crowd, specifically following the England goal. These pyrotechnics were believed to have been sold by the event organisers. The first aiders on scene reported treating individual's for burn injuries believed to have been sustained through the reckless ignition of such items. As a precaution, I preemptively made contact with HFRS for shared situational awareness should they receive any calls for service and they generated their log reference 15939. The release of flares and smoke bombs led to a number of minor injuries. There is a list of injured individuals recorded on HP-20260715-0392 at 00:39 who have obtained medical treatment from the medical staff at the event. There are also details for the medical lead for the event who believed that alcohol was being sold by the food vendors there.

Again pockets of disorder involving small numbers of individuals occurred as the match finished and the event dispersed. These included reports of fights between small groups and a call to service from McDonalds who reported criminal damage to the drive thru window and a large amount of people trying to enter the store. As a result McDonalds closed 25minutes early. Officers in attendance at this

location report issues with traffic management and a lot of tension being created by vehicles being unable to leave the area effectively due to volume and poor management.
