

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
ROXTON ROAD, IMMINGHAM
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 26-065) ORDER 2026)

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

- ROXTON ROAD – Starting from its junction with STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD, in a northerly direction, for a distance of 170 metres.

Alternative route: Stallingborough Road, Keelby Road, A1173, B1210 Stallingborough Road, Roxton Road (reverse route applies).

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Utility Works. These works are detailed as required for safe of duct works..

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 07 September 2026** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Roxton Road, Immingham (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 26-065), Order 2026"
