

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
HABROUGH LEVEL CROSSING, BROCKLESBY ROAD, HABROUGH,
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 26-080) ORDER 2026)

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along on the below sections of highway:

- A section of B1210 BROCKLESBY ROAD – Part length, from a point 20 meters north-east of HABROUGH LEVEL CROSSING to a point 20 metres south east of HABROUGH LEVEL CROSSING.

Alternative route: Station Road, Habrough Road, Immingham Road, Stallingborough Road, A1173, A18, B1211 Brocklesby Road

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by The Chevron Group. These works are detailed as rail depth inspection.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Saturday, 05 September 2026** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no exemptions to the order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Habrough Level Crossing, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 26-080), Order 2026"
