

Licensing Act 2003

Representation by any Person or Licence/Certificate Holder following an Application to Review a Premises Licence or Club Premises Certificate



Representations may be made at any time during a period of 28 consecutive days starting on the day after the application for review was given to the Licensing Authority.

In the case of a closure order issued by the Police, representations may be made during the seven days that follow relevant notice being given to the Local Authority by the Magistrates Court, starting on the day after the day the notice was received.

Representations are only relevant to an application if they relate to at least one of the four **Licensing Objectives** listed below:

- **The Prevention of Crime and Disorder**
- **Public Safety**
- **Prevention of Public Nuisance**
- **The Protection of Children from Harm**

Representations can be made about an application for review by any person. Representations may be made on behalf of the above by a representative e.g. MP, solicitor, or a friend.

Objectives	Evidence
The Prevention of Crime and Disorder	We respectfully ask the Licensing Sub-Committee not to revoke the premises licence for Ob Turkish Restaurant. This is a small family-run business and the restaurant is our only source of income. We never intentionally employed an illegal worker or tried to breach immigration laws.

Public Safety	Before allowing [redacted] to assist at the restaurant, we requested and checked the documents that were provided to us, including her ARC card and National Insurance number. We also relied on advice from our accountant, who informed us that she was permitted to work. We now understand that the correct Home Office verification process was not completed and that additional checks should have been carried out. However, this was due to misunderstanding and reliance on incorrect professional advice, not deliberate wrongdoing. Since this incident, we have started implementing
Prevention of Public Nuisance	Stricter right-to-work procedures and are employing a new accountant to ensure full future compliance with home office requirements. Revoking the premises license would have devastating consequences for our family and business. We support a large family and business through this business, including young children and a child with additional needs.
The Protection of Children from Harm	We respectfully ask the committee to consider our cooperation, corrective actions, personal circumstances, and the fact that this was not intentional, and to consider alternatives to revocation.

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives

Revocation of the premises licence would effectively force the closure of our family business.

The business already facing significant financial challenges, including VAT liabilities, business rates, council tax arrears, utility costs and reduced trade. In addition, major construction works in Market street and the loss of nearby parking have had a serious impact on customer numbers and turnover.

Despite these difficulties, we have continued to operate lawfully, support our employees and take steps to improve compliance.

We respectfully ask the Committee to consider that revocation would not only affect the business, but also the livelihood of an entire family who depend on it as their sole source of income.
