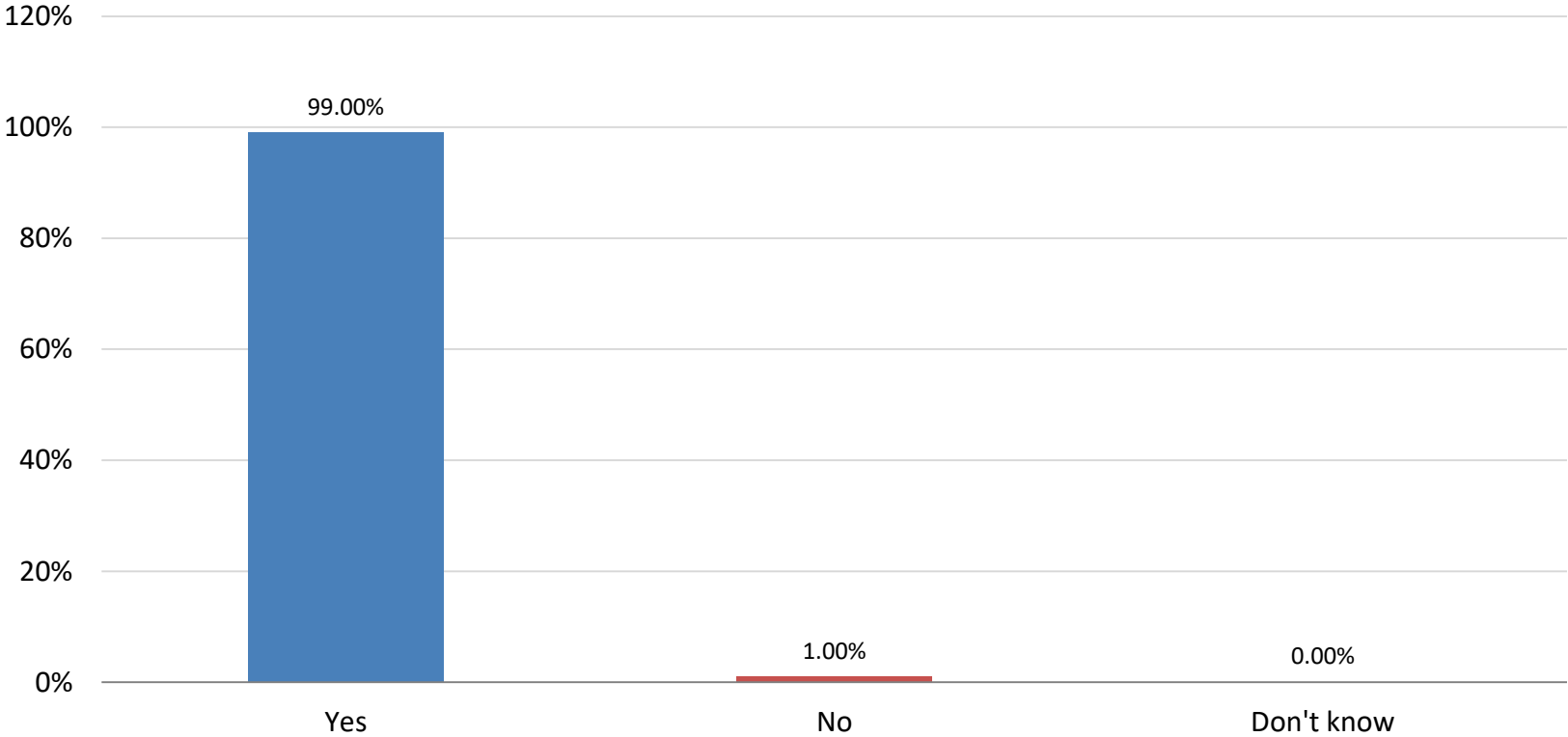


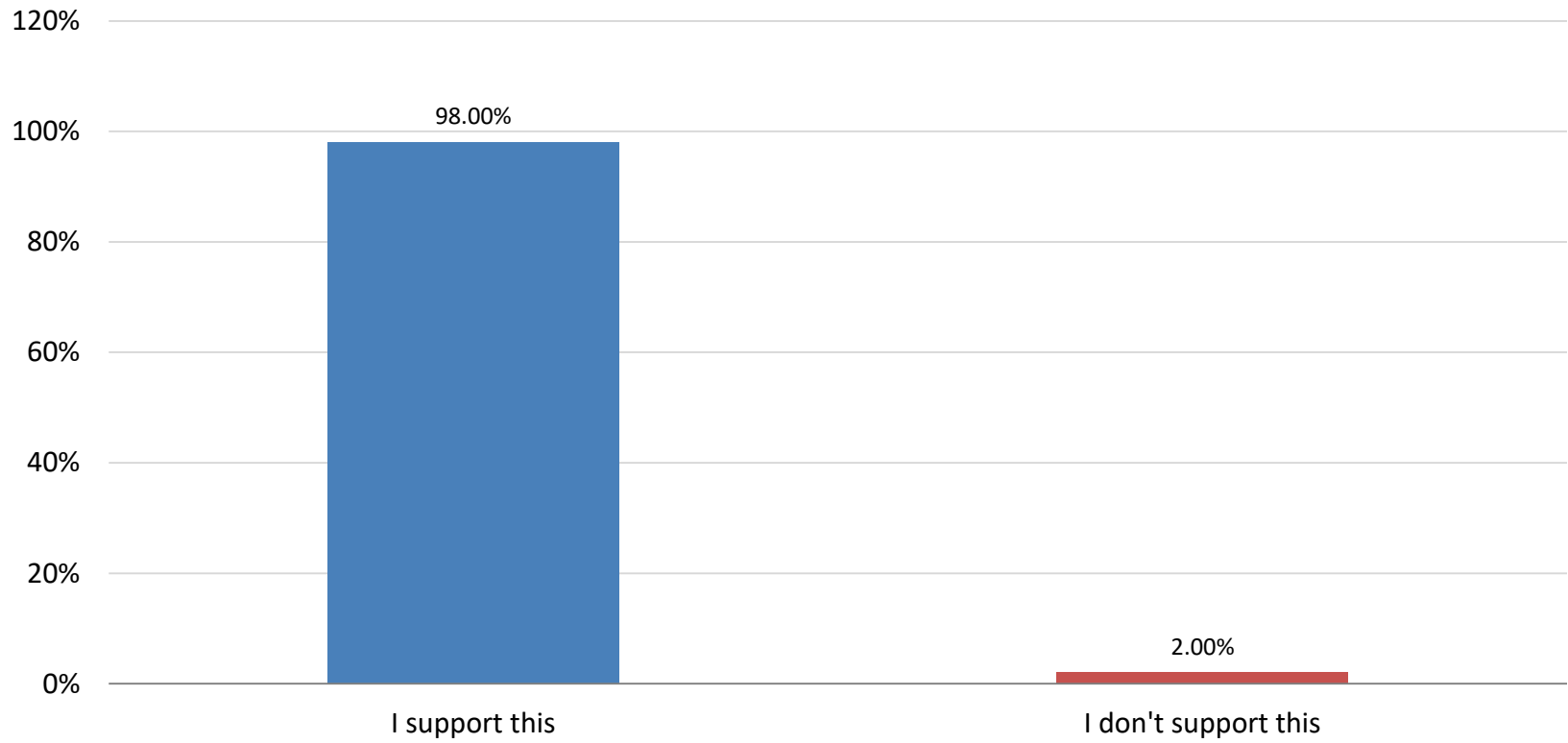

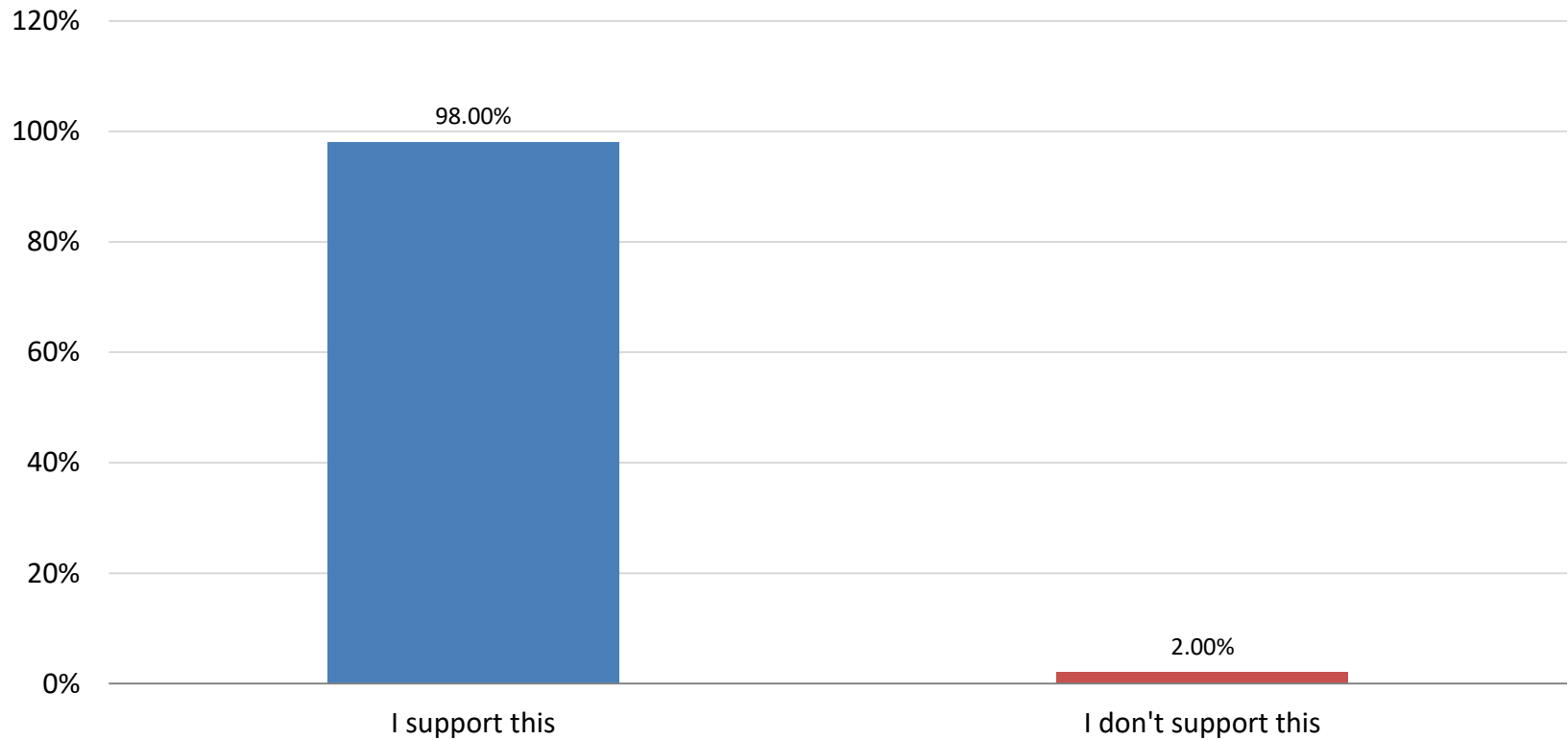
# In general, do you believe that public places should be safe and free from dog mess?



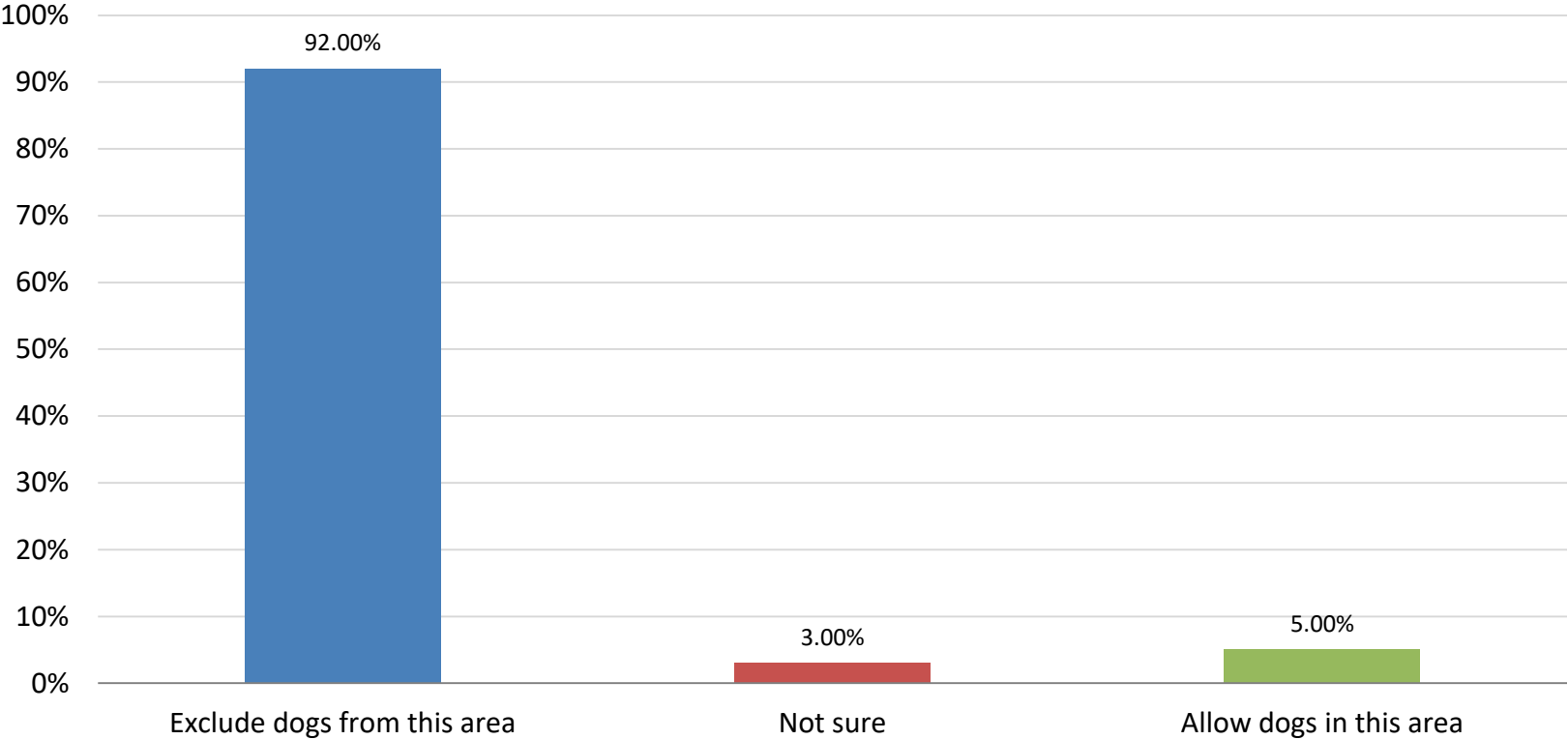

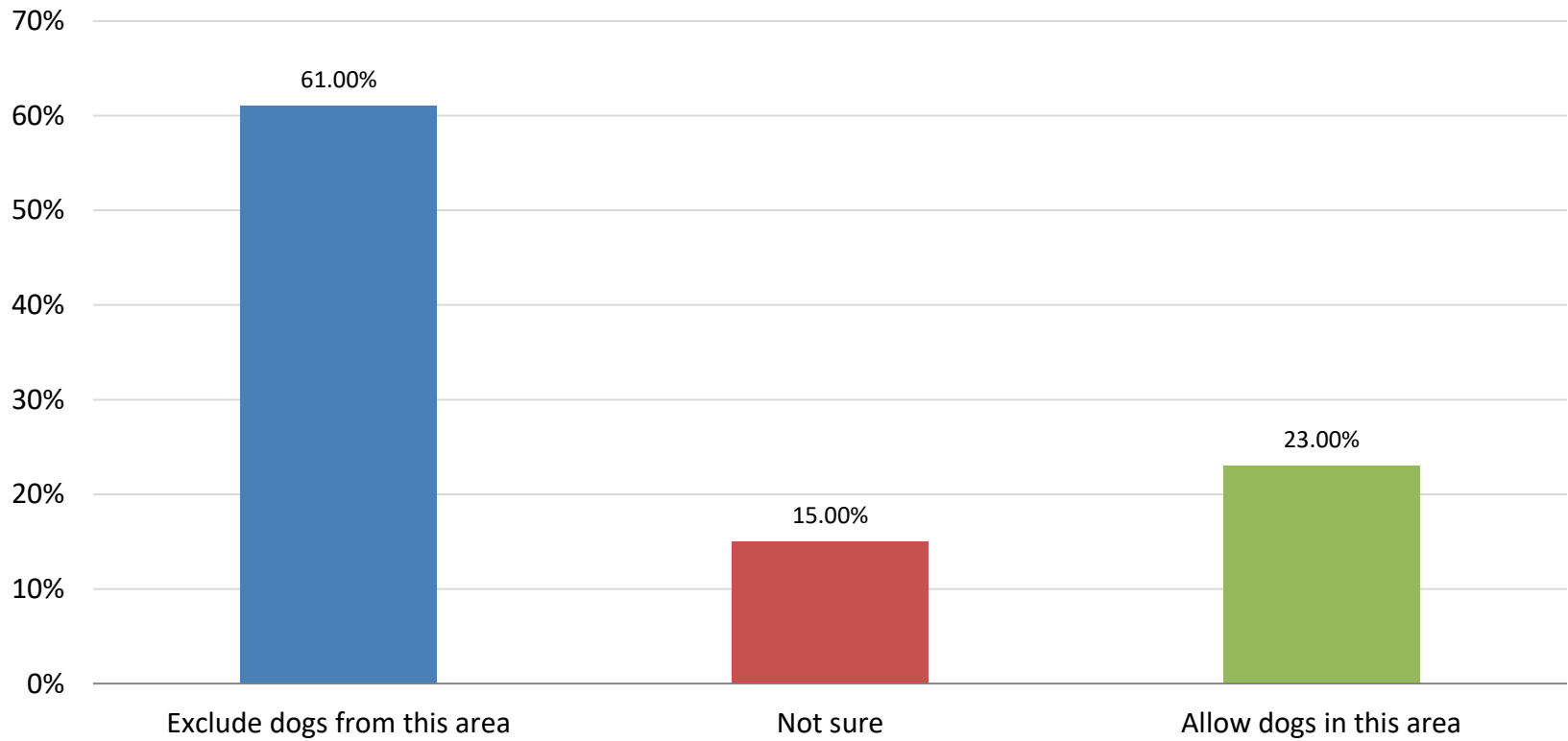
Leads by order – This covers the need for people to put and keep a dog, whose behaviour causes concern, on a lead when directed to do so by an authorised officer.



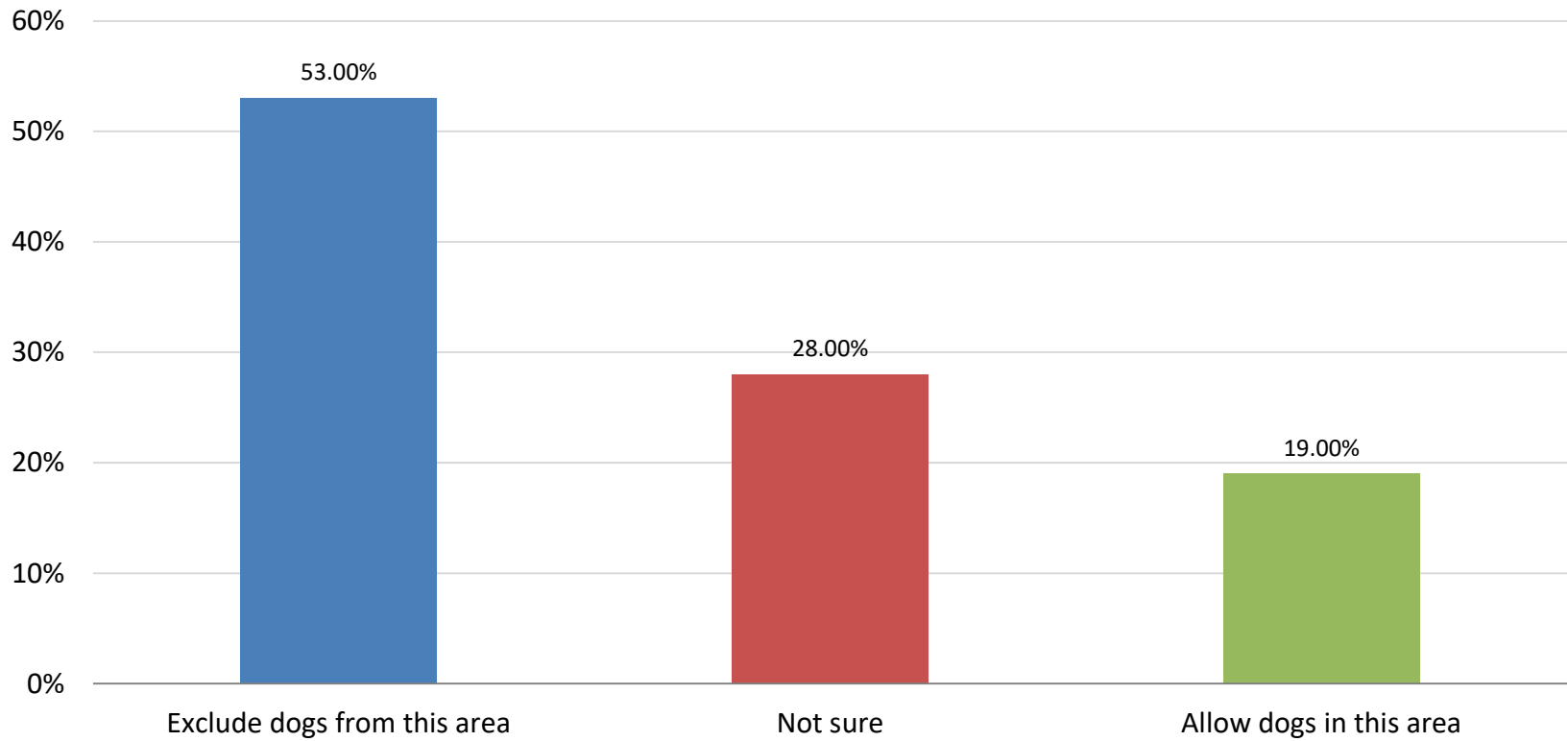

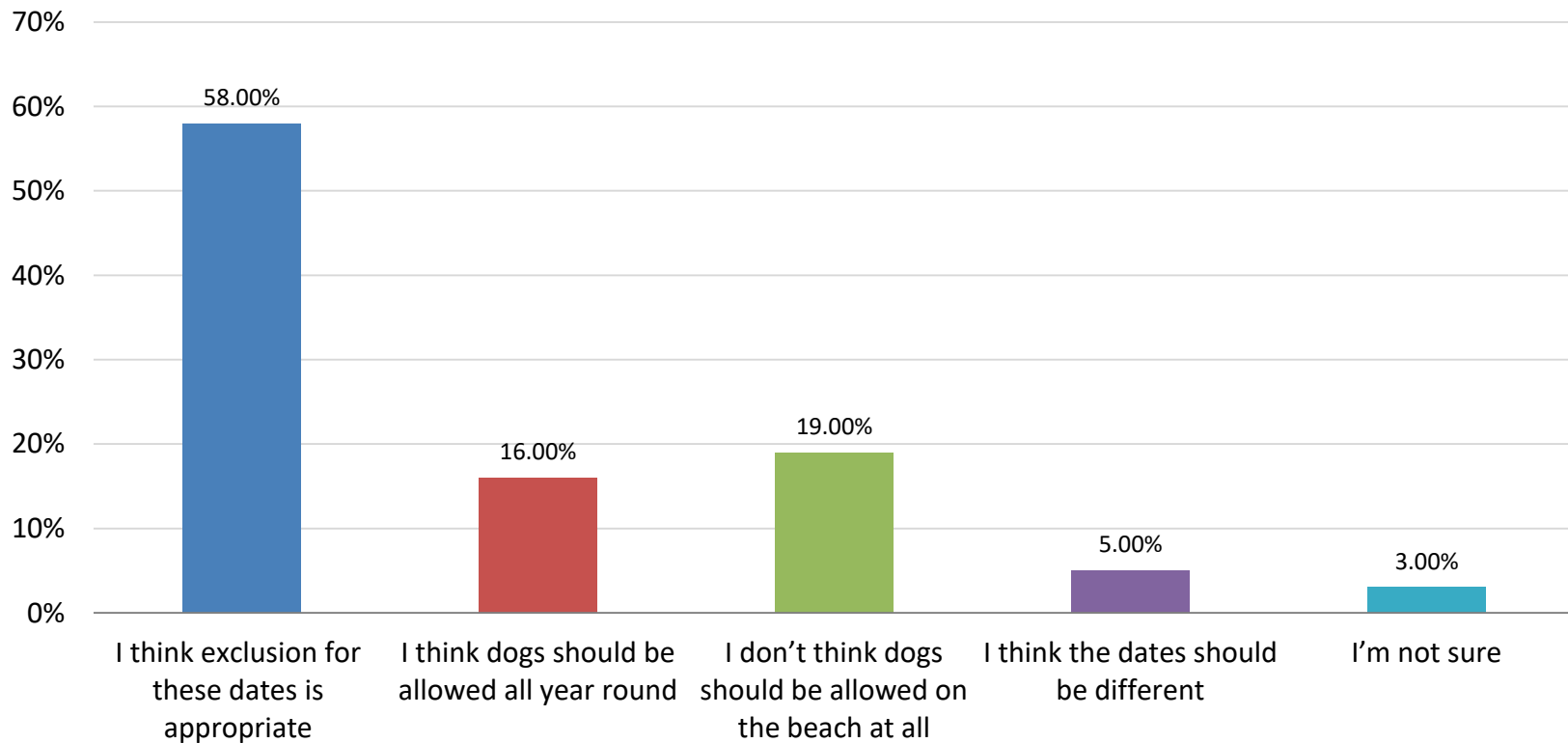

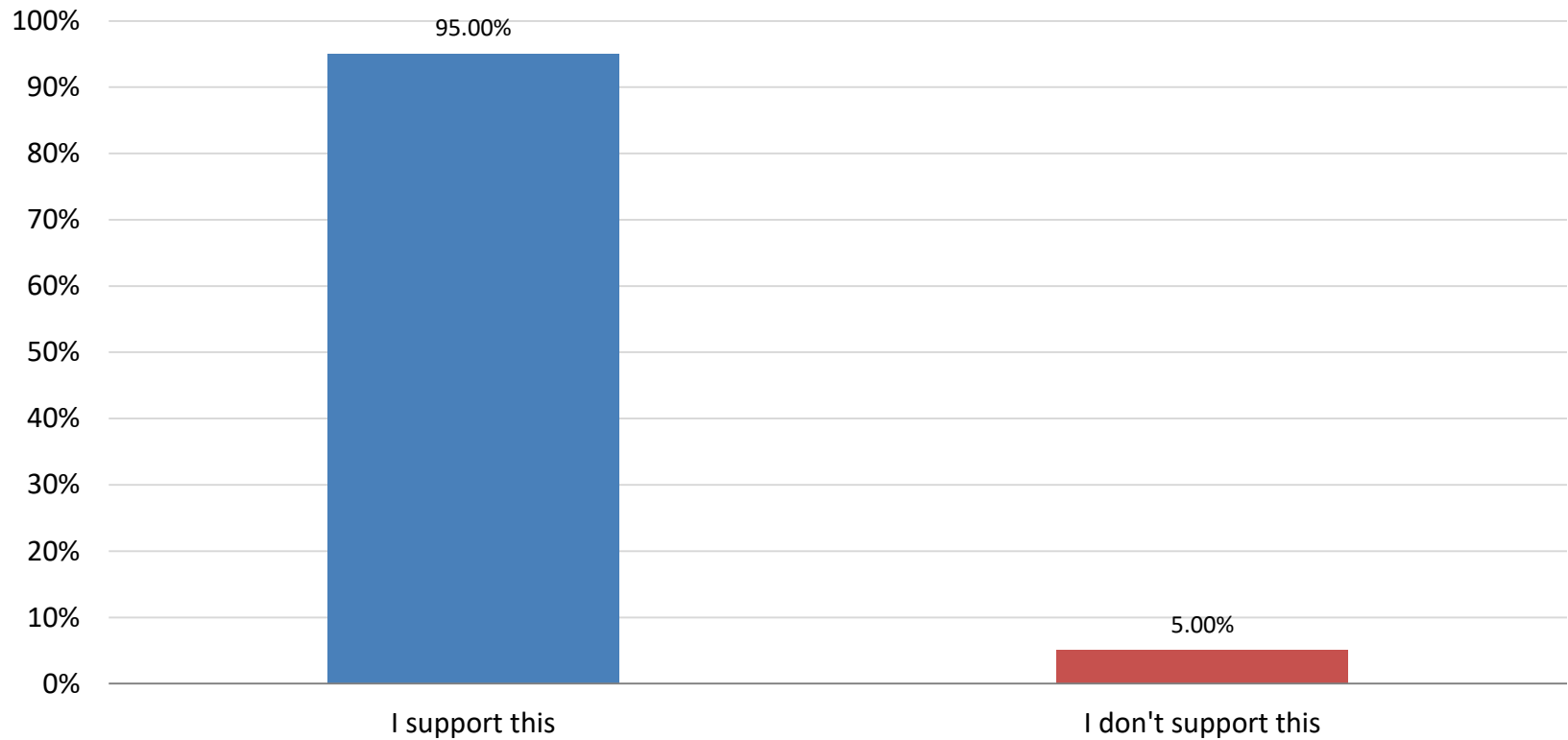


Dogs are currently excluded from Cleethorpes beach between Good Friday and 30th September each year. How best describes how you feel about dogs on the beach:

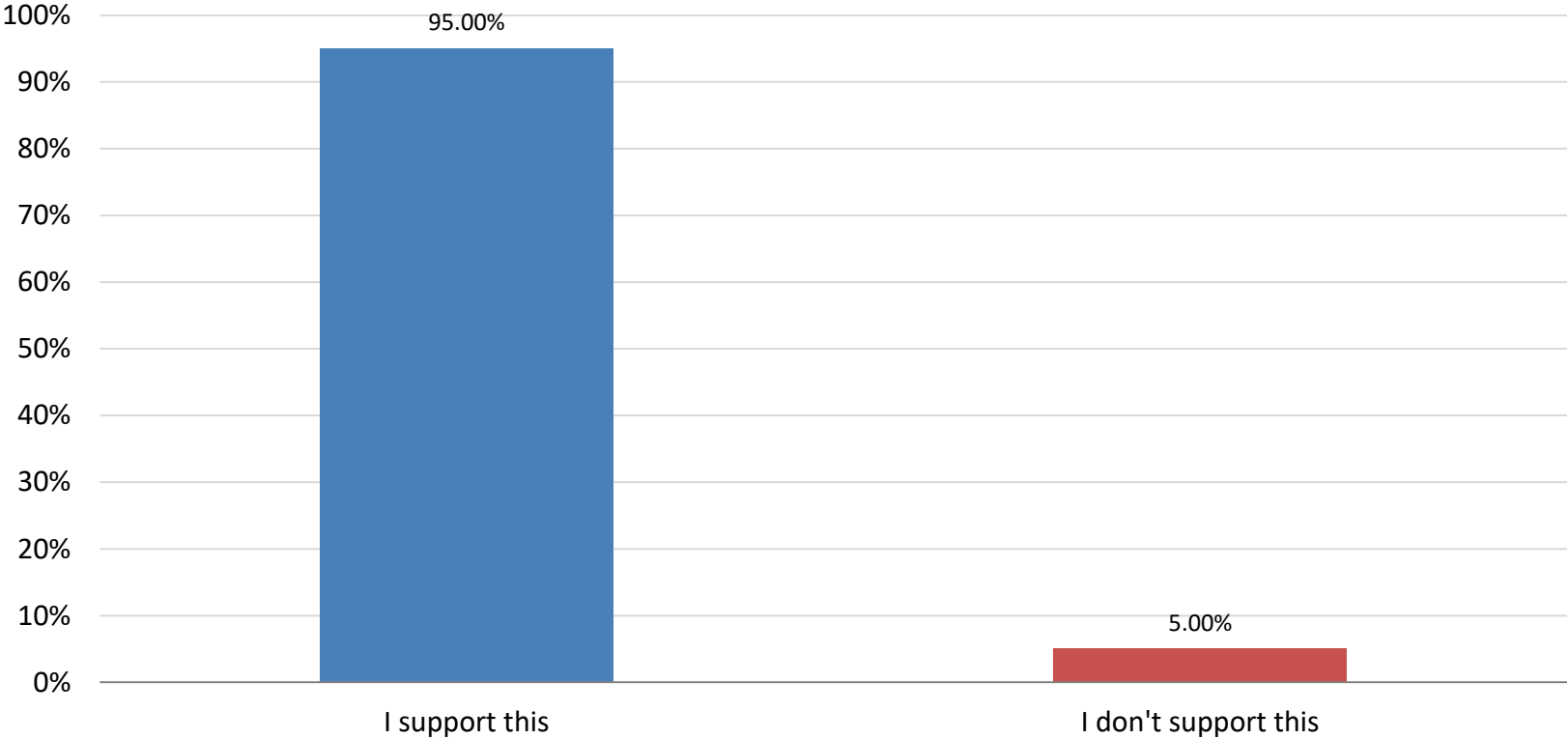




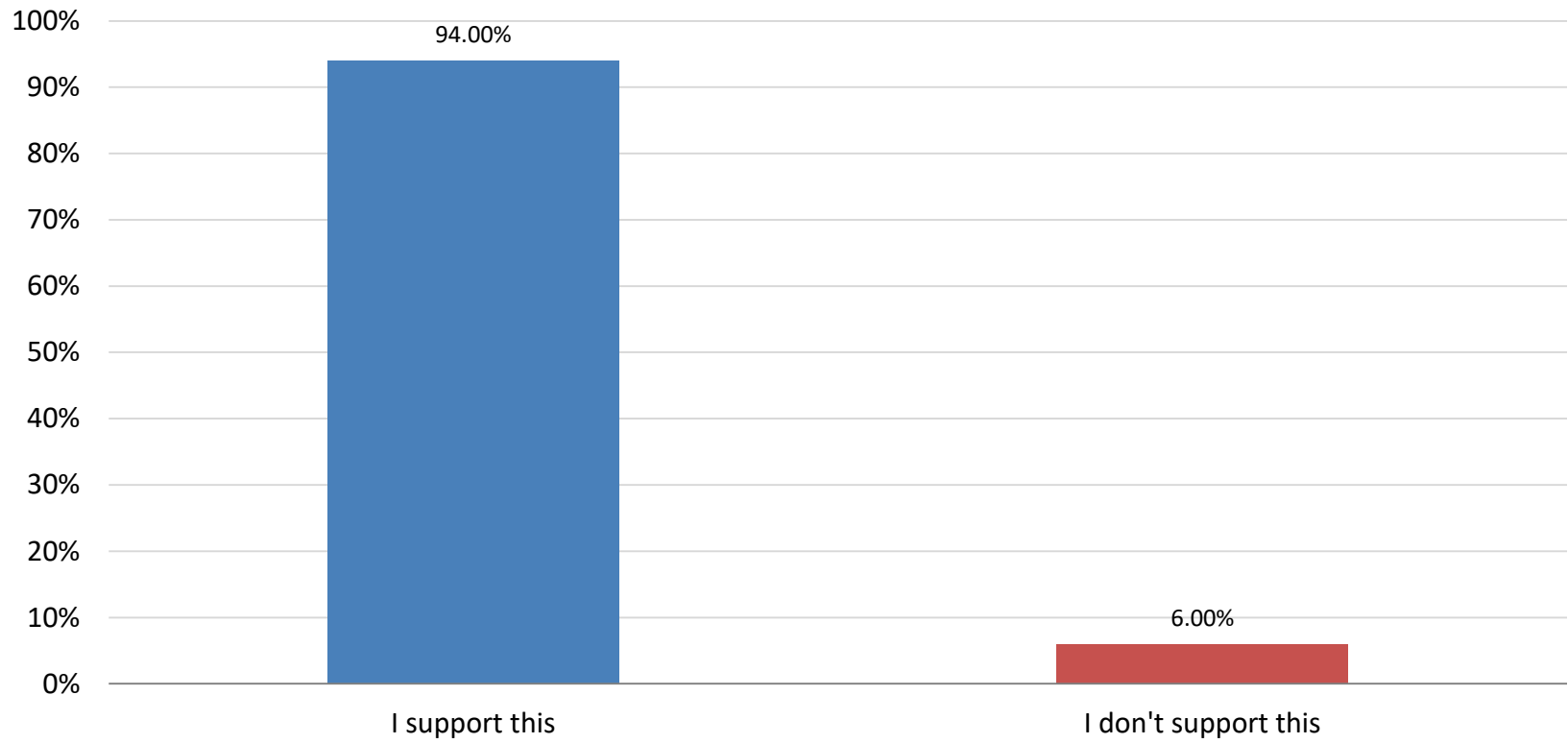
